





Tips to managing food waste

Tip #1 - Shop Responsibly

Make a shopping list of items you need before you get to the supermarket. Only buy enough fresh foods fro a week. Choose shelf-stable foods like canned goods, pasta, rice and legumes. Utilise your freezer to store bread, meats, vegetables and fruit.



Tip #2 - Plan meals & save leftovers



Taking an inventory of your pantry is a great first step to plan your meals and avoid food waste. Check expiration dates to use foods before they go bad. Plan meals that build on one another and provide leftovers for lunches and second meals.

Tip #3 - Use a food waste disposer

With even moderate use, food waste disposers are proven to reduce the amount of food waste in your trash by up to 30%. Using a disposal keeps stinky food scraps out of your trash and reduces harmful bacteria – all while diverting food waste from the landfill.



Tip #4 - Grind more than you would think



Today's food waste disposers enable you to grind more types of food waste than you may realize. Chicken bones, fruit pits and fibrous fruit and vegetable skins are all safe with proper usage.

Dispelling the myths

Does a disposer have blades?

No, food waste disposers do not have blades. They quickly and quietly grind food waste using swivel lugs and MultiGrind Technology™.

Does a disposer clog drains?

Modern disposers grind food waste into very fine particles. Also, food waste is 70-80% water, so easily travels through drains.

Does a disposer use a lot of water & power?

Although operating a food waste disposer does involve running water and using electricity, the environmental impact is minimal. Disposers use only about 1% of a household's total water consumption (about one flush of the toilet per day) and cost approximately \$2 per year in electricity to operate.

Are disposers noisy?

InSinkErator Sound Limiter insulation and Anti-Vibration Mount Technology mean the Evolution™ models can operate with minimal noise versus standard disposers. We also recommend installing a quality sink, which can eliminate vibration and noise

Do you need a double sink?

A food waste disposer can be installed with both a single or double bowl sink. Check sink and food waste disposer dimensions for details.

You can't put that down a disposer?

A food waste disposer can handle a wide range of food waste including, fruits, veggies, chicken bones, fish bones. Tea bags (without strings or staples), egg shells, avocado skins/stones and celery.

A little history



1927

Tinkering with an idea and some sheet metal, Racine architect John W. Hammes invents the first food waste disposer.



The 1940s

Bob Cox, vice president of sales sold disposers to plumbers instead of appliance dealers and by 1952 he pitched the product out of pink Pontiac.



The 1950s

As television came of age, so did television advertising, using the power of celebrity endorsements of George Burns, Barbara Walters, and later Phyllis Diller.

The 1960s

Emerson Electric Co. purchases InSinkErator.



The 1970s

InSinkErator started producing Trash Compactor and Hot Water Dispensers.



New York City Department of Environmental Study concluded a two-year analysis, and approved the use of food waste disposers.



2000 and beyond

The Evolution Series® was launched coming with advanced sound, grind, anti-jam and antivibration technologies. The MultiTap was launched in the UK in 2016, providing near-boiling water, with standard hot and filtered cold water, all from one tap.
